KEY POINTS

ISAIAH 53:3-12, PAGE 613-614

1. Who killed Jesus?
2. What was the motivation to do so?
3. Reconciliation with humanity was his purpose.
 - a. All sins are against God.
 - b. He is the “offended” party.
 - c. Something must be done with our sins to be reconciled with God. The cross is the answer to our need for reconciliation with God.

KEY POINTS

4. The cross is the means by which God reconciled humanity to himself.
 - a. God is good, loving, and just.
 - b. All aspects of his character must be simultaneously fulfilled – not just love.
5. What will you do with your sins?

Next Steps.

1. Pray this prayer on a daily basis (Dr. Alvin Reed): “God give me today:
 1. An opportunity to speak with someone about Jesus;
 2. The eyes to see it;
 3. The courage to take it.”
