

WALKING IN BIBLICAL MANHOOD – PART 2 GENESIS 2:15-17; 3:17

 "Doing" is the central component of responsibility.

RESPONSIBLE – having an obligation to do something, or having control over or care for someone, as part of one's job or role.

1. GOD DECLARED ADAM AS "THE" RESPONSIBLE PARTY.

A. For himself (and family). 2:15, 24

- 1. "Took the man and put him ..."
- 2. To work and keep; not Rev 22:2
- 3. From consumer to producer
- 4. Suicide (45 and younger) in America (CDC)
- B. For the animals. 2:19
- C. For the Word of God. 2:16-17

"LEADER" OR "RESPONSIBLE PARTY"?.

- For as <u>by a man came death</u>, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.²² For <u>as in Adam</u> all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. (1 Cor. 15:21-22)
- Therefore, just as sin came into the world <u>through</u> <u>one man</u>, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned-- (Rom. 5:12)

Consumer vs producer

- How I spend my time
- Homework; chores
- Spiritual health
- My sins; addictions

BIBLICAL MANHOOD REQUIRES:

A. Acceptance of responsibility and doing accordingly. *("You are responsible for your face")*



2. GOD HONORED HIS WORD TO THE MAN.

- A. Placed it in the center of the Garden. 3:3
- B. Commanded it be kept. 2:16-17
- C. Made the man an advocate of it; a witness to what it said. 2:17, 3:3

Matt. 24:12 And because lawlessness will be increased, <u>the</u> <u>love of many will</u> <u>grow cold</u>. (ESV)

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN MEN STOP HONORING THE BIBLE?

- They don't read it. They don't follow it. Flesh controls.
 - Men are consumers instead of producers.
 - Youth have no moral compass; violence is normal.
 - Injustice prevails.
 - Women are victimized.
 - Sexual abuse abounds.

A. God had compassion on Adam.
Not good for man to be alone. 2:18, 20
B. Biblical men "suffer with" the hurting.
Phil 2:5-8

BARY 3. MAN IS CALLED TO CULTIVATE A HEART OF COMPASSION BY SERVING OTHERS.

Phil. 2:5-8 Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, 6 who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 <u>but emptied himself</u>, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in human form, <u>he humbled himself</u> by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

BIBLICAL MANHOOD REQUIRES:

A. Acceptance of responsibility and doing accordingly.

B. Honoring the word of God in my life.

C. Cultivating a heart of compassion by serving others.
