Psalm 139:1-6

- 1) O LORD, you have searched me and known me!
- 2) You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar.



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Psalm 139:1-6

- 3) You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways.
- 4) Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O LORD, you know it altogether.

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Psalm 139:1-6

- 5) You hem me in, behind and before,
and lay your hand upon me.
- 6) Such knowledge is too wonderful for
me; it is high; I cannot attain it.

I. God's Omniscience

Infinite Knowledge (v.1-6)

- God knows everything.
- God's infinite knowledge is not something to skim over when thinking about the value He places on life.
- God gives us all the knowledge we need to handle the situations in front of us.

Colossians 1:9

“And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding”

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Psalm 139:7-12

- 7) Where shall I go from your Spirit?
Or where shall I flee from your
presence?
- 8) If I ascend to heaven, you are there!
If I make my bed in Sheol, you are
there!

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Psalm 139:7-12

- 9) If I take the wings of the morning
and dwell in the uttermost parts of
the sea,
- 10) Even there your hand shall lead me,
and your right hand shall hold me.

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Psalm 139:7-12

- 11) If I say, “Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night,”
- 12) Even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you.

II. God's Omnipresence Present everywhere at the same time (v.7-12)

- God is everywhere at all times.
- God dwells with us in every aspect of our lives, from the high's to the low's.
- God is absolutely inescapable. We cannot hide from God in darkness. He can see us just as clear in the dark as in the light.

Psalm 139:13-18

13) For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb.

14) I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.

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Psalm 139:13-18

- 15) My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth.
- 16) Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them.

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Psalm 139:13-18

- 17) How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!
- 18) If I would count them, they are more than the sand. I awake, and I am still with you.



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III. God's Omnipresence

Infinite Power (v.13-18)

- God is all powerful
- God is specific in His planning, and in His thoughts towards life. His value of life is one of precision, and care no matter the state of your existence, God values you.
- God is thinking about each one of our lives from the womb to the tomb.
