



## 1. Jesus taught like none before ... or after.

- John 8:1-2 (Early in the morning...all)
- •Luke 19:47-48 And he was teaching daily in the temple. The chief priests and the scribes and the principal men of the people were seeking to destroy him, <sup>48</sup> but they did not find anything they could do, for all the people were hanging on his words.

• Luk 8:18 Take care then how you hear, for to the one who has, more will be given, and from the one who has not, even what he thinks that he has will be taken away."



## 2. Jesus defined "without sin" as a "God-only" attribute.

•John 8:7-9 And as they continued to ask him, he stood up and said to them, "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her." ...



## 3. Jesus is our savior not our judge.

- •John 3:17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.
- •1 John 3:5 You know that he appeared in order to take away sins,. ... The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.

### 4. Greatest barrier to knowing Jesus is an absence of need.

- •John 8:9 But when they heard it, they went away one by one, beginning with the older ones, ...
- •Mat 9:12 But when he heard it, he said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick."



#### 5. Was Jesus "light" on sin?

• John 8:9-11 ..., and Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before him. 10 Jesus stood up and said to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" 11 She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more."
