1. One word (“logos” in Greek) describes who Jesus is and was.

Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷ but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. (Phil. 2:6-7 NIV)



2. One word (“logos”) describes Jesus’ creative nature and his desire that we enjoy his handiwork.



3. One word (“logos”) envisions the content of God’s vision for us – God with us!

4. **God seals the “logos” until we receive the gift of Logos by faith.**
 - John 1:11-13
