Nehemiah 12:44-47

Context

- -Two books from one
- -A powerful position to a powerful obedience
- -The restoration of Jerusalem



The heart realizes a Faithful God

-Despite opposition, Jerusalem had been restored; God had delivered on His promise

-God had brought the people out of oppression and back into His city (the remnant)

-God sets the standard for faithfulness



The heart through the condition of the people

-The circumstance of the people while giving

-An economic and political crisis

-They still recognized the importance of giving



The heart in an act of worship

-Nehemiah's act of worship

-Going through the motions versus worshipping God

-Worshipping through acts of obedience
