

Moses

Exodus 3:13-14; 4:1-5; 4:10-13

1. God has an ear for our chaos. He cannot, not enter it.

V 2:24-25 And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, God saw the people of Israel-- and God knew.

V 3:7-8 Then the LORD said, "I have surely seen the affliction of my people ... and have heard their cry ... I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them.

V 3:6. God identified himself.

V 3:8. God told Moses his plan.

V 3:10. God asked Moses to join him.

Moses needed a spiritual awakening to be a Hero of Hope for God. V 3:13, 15. Who shall I say sent me?

V4:1. They won't believe me. "What is in your hand, Moses?"

V4:13. Get someone else, please. ... And Aaron will join you.

Application.

If God can use a "Moses," God can use you! Will you be a "Hero of Hope" in another person's chaos?
