

- 1. How can I trust God...? Recall what God has done in your life.
- Heb. 11:3 By faith we <u>understand</u> that the universe was <u>created by the word of God</u>, so that <u>what is seen</u> was not made out of things that are visible. (ESV)
- Romans 1:20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

- 2. How can I trust God...? Learn from others. Faith is a "learned behavior."
 - Heb. 11:4 By faith Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice than Cain, through which he was commended as righteous, God commending him by accepting his gifts. And through his faith, though he died, he still speaks. (ESV).

 Gen. 4:4 and Abel also brought of the <u>firstborn of his</u> <u>flock and of their fat portions</u>. And the LORD had regard for Abel and his offering, (ESV)

- 3. How can I trust God...? Walk with God. Act on what he says.
- Heb. 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith. (ESV)

How can we trust God for the unseen?

- 1. Look at the evidence. Make a daily journal of what he has done.
- 2. Learn faith from those around you. Talk about it with your family, friends, your church. Make a faith statement a part of your daily prayers.
- 3. Walk with the Spirit of God by diligently seeking him in your life. Act on what He says.
