WORKS HEART



"Kintsugi" – non-Christian art form.

- Literally, "golden mending."
- Repairing broken pottery by mending the areas of breakage with lacquer, dusted or mixed with powdered gold.
- Treats breakage and repair as history rather than something to disguise or cover.



1. The woman was known by her "history." Society had already discarded her.

Luke 7:39, ... he said to himself, "... He [Jesus] should know what <u>sort</u> of woman this is who is touching him, that <u>she is</u> <u>a sinner</u>."



2. Simon is the one who is still broken. He can't see his own "cracks."

- Luke 7:41-42
- We all fall short:
 - Rom 3:23
 - Eccl 7:20
 - Rom 5:12
 - 1 John 1:8
 - Isa 64:6

- **3.** Jesus has a heart for the broken because the broken have surrendered to what he has to offer.
- Isa. 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;
- Isa. 53:5 But He was <u>pierced through for our</u> <u>transgressions</u>, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.
- Luke 7:50, Your faith has saved you. Go in peace.



4. Jesus is the "river of gold" that mends our brokenness.

- Col. 2:13-14 "..., having forgiven us ..., 14 by canceling the record of debt that stood against us ... This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. (ESV)
- 2 Cor 5:17 Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.
