3. We are called to embrace our troubles in the knowledge that Jesus has them not the other way around.

• 1 Cor. 10:2-4 and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, 3 and all ate the same spiritual food, 4 and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ. (ESV)



- Yea though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. (Ps. 23:4 NAU)
- Isa 43:2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; ...
- Psa 27:1 Of David. The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- Lam. 3:24 "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in him." (ESV)
