- Romans 10:1-4

- Romans 10:5-10
- Salvation is very near to us; our mouth and heart
- Other worldviews...
- Deuteronomy 30:1-16
- The Levitical Law vs Christ

3. There is no distinction in salvation

- Romans 10:11-13
- Who is the Gospel for?
- Our tendency to set ourselves apart
- God gives the full measure of salvation to all who call
