 4. The Holy Spirit now has room to work – to change us.

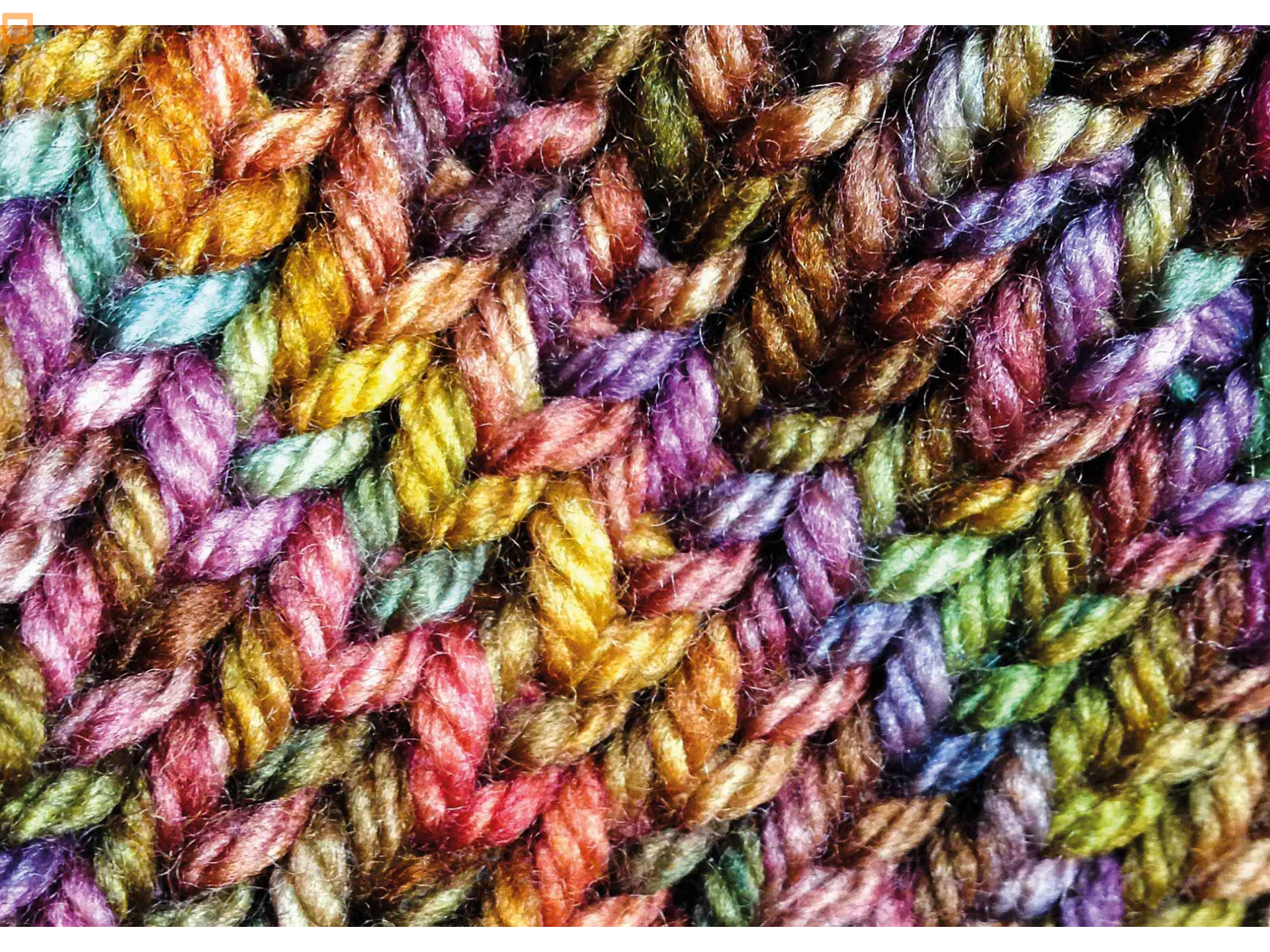




2. What does “B1” look like? A church continually devoted to the things of the Holy Spirit.
