# I. THE INEVITABILITY OF ANXIETY

- Matthew 6:25
- God knows His creation
- Anxiety comes from the fall
- Anxiety from a misplaced focus on the world and others (Matthew 6:19-24)
- Christ can relate, because He experienced everything

## 2. SEEKING HIS KINGDOM

- Matthew 6:32-33
- Christ's solution to anxiety; be kingdom minded
- The example of Solomon
- Gideon's fleece
- If we are living according to how God desires for us to live, kingdom minded and defined by Scripture, then we have the freedom to choose and make decisions
- In all situations, seek God's kingdom first
