



# B1 to Reach 1 Matt 28:16-20



Above all, put on love,  
which is the perfect  
bond of unity.



1. The “Great Commission” proves itself to be the work of God.

**Matt. 28:19-20** Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (ESV)



# The other gospels:

**Mk. 16:15-16** And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. <sup>16</sup> Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. (ESV)



## The other gospels:

**Lk. 24:46-48** and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, <sup>47</sup> and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <sup>48</sup> You are witnesses of these things.



## Luke's continuation in Acts:

**Acts 1:8** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (ESV)



## Other gospels:

**Jn. 20:30-31** Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; <sup>31</sup> but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name. (ESV)







2. All believers in Jesus are commissioned to “go” as Jesus went.

**Matt. 28:18-19** And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples ..., baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.







3. All believers in Jesus are commissioned to be disciple makers.

**Matt. 28:19-20** Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
