1. Jesus is aware of the 3x against her.
John 4:16 vs 4:10.
 2. Jesus offers a new drink.
 3. Which “hydria” will she drink from?

3. Jesus needed to “hand the ball off” to the 12. They had to take hold of it and give it to another.

1. Harvest is now. V35.

2. Lift up your eyes. v35

3. Give it away. Pass it on. V39
