He Keeps His Promises

Objectives of Series:

1. That we ***embrace***, welcome, the 3rd person of the Trinity, the HS; that our fears of the HS would be replaced by our friendship with the HS.
2. That we ***become reliant*** upon the power of the HS so that our verbal witness of Jesus might be filled with the HS.
3. That we ***be re-invigorated*** by the HS so that we might be useful for the purposes of the HS, whatever that might be.

PAUL'S FIRST MISSIONARY JOURNEY

AD 44-46

1. Paul reminded them of what they already knew about God: He keeps his promises bc He loves us and is for us. Jesus is the fruit of God's love for us.

1. Chosen by God. v 17.
2. Put up w them – 40 years; 450 years of relationship.
3. Jesus - God keeps his promises. He is our refuge.



2. Paul brought them to a “fork in the road.”
What they believed about Jesus was either the doorway to the good news or a door they locked and then tossed the key.

1. The prophets foretold of a Savior.
2. The resurrection is God’s proof that Jesus is that Savior. v32-33
3. Forgiveness and freedom are yours if you receive him. V 13:38-39.
4. Which “voice” will we listen to?



3. God searched for a man after his own heart – He found David. God's Spirit indwells believers to encourage them to find Him and surrender their wills to His.

- ..., he raised up David to be their king, of whom he testified and said, 'I have found in David the son of Jesse a man ***after my heart, who will do all my will.***' (Acts 13:22)
- Acts 2:38, 5:32.
