## Have you seen *the salvation* God has prepared for you? Everything begins here.

 V31. "For my eyes have seen your salvation that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel."

- 3. Commit to daily "abiding in the true vine" of Jesus.
- 4. Act on your entrustments.
