



Does Your Jesus Walk on Water?


Matt 14:22-33






1. When life goes badly, Jesus will walk on water.

- **Which side of your change is Jesus on? Finding which side is imperative to making change real in your life.**




2. **What got Peter out of the boat in the middle of the storm?**

3. Why did Peter sink after he had the faith to walk on water?


- A. Took his eyes off Jesus. V29-30.
