- Gifts from the HS. V11
- To each. V7, Rom 2:11
- B. Why given?
 - John 14:12 Christ not physically present.
 - 1 Cor 12:27 works thru believers.
 - John 14:16-18 Helper.
 - John 3:16 God loves.

C. What purpose? Will God's purpose give me purpose? V 12:18, Rev 22:17

2. The blueprint of the HS to reach our world is all encompassing. Gifts are how He empowers us for His divine purpose.

- A. Three different gift-categories ("GSA"):
 - V4. "varieties of gifts," I.e., spiritual not DNA based (talents).
 - 2. V5. "*varieties* of service," i.e., ministries. *Could* be DNA based, talents. Heart to do...
 - 3. V6. "varieties of activities," "works," when the HS does a specific work in one's life. My "story."

B. Gifts are diverse, with a divine purpose for the whole.

 The whole is greater than the sum of the parts. V4, 5, 6, 11. No "lone ranger" Christians.

- 3. Does the HS have expectations for believers? Does He make promises when I answer His call?
- A. Expected to "*manifest* the Holy Spirit for the common good." 2 Cor 2:14
- B. Expected to discover my gifts, to desire more.
 - 1 Cor. 12:31 But earnestly desire the higher gifts...
 - 14:1 Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, ...
- C. Expected to faithfully use my gifts to build up His church. Eph 4:11-13. 1 Peter 4:10
- D. If we do, the promise of the Holy Spirit is rewards.

Expectations of the Holy Spirit.

 1 Peter 4:10 As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: 11 whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ

The Promise of the HS

 1 Cor. 3:5-8 What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. ⁶ I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. ⁷ So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. ⁸ He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor. (ESV)
