- Hungry?

- 1:50, "good" And his *mercy* is for those who *fear him* from generation to generation.

## GREAT EXPECTATIONS

3. To believe God for the unseen – I must commit myself to God's will and plan, whatever that might be.

A. She "wrestled" with her doubts. V 34.

- B. She believed him for the impossible.
- C. She committed her will to His plan.
  - Be it done to me ... v 38.
  - Not intellectual act.
- D. She acted on what was given.
  - God gave the witness. v39.

## GREAT EXPECTATIONS

Nothing is impossible for God.

- Gen 18:14, "Is anything too hard for the Lord? ..."
- Mat 19:26, "... With men this is impossible, but with all things are possible."
- Luke 1:37, "For nothing will be impossible with God."
- Mark 14:36, " ... Abba, Father, all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."



 Mary's point of decision exchanged her plans for God's plans. It was her anchor for the difficulties the future would hold for her.

- But Mary treasured up all these things, *pondering them in her heart*. (Lk. 2:19 ESV).
- And Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is appointed for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign that is opposed (Lk. 2:34 ESV)
- And he went down with them and came to Nazareth and was submissive to them. And his mother treasured up all these things in her heart. (Lk. 2:51 GREAT EXPECTATIONS
