



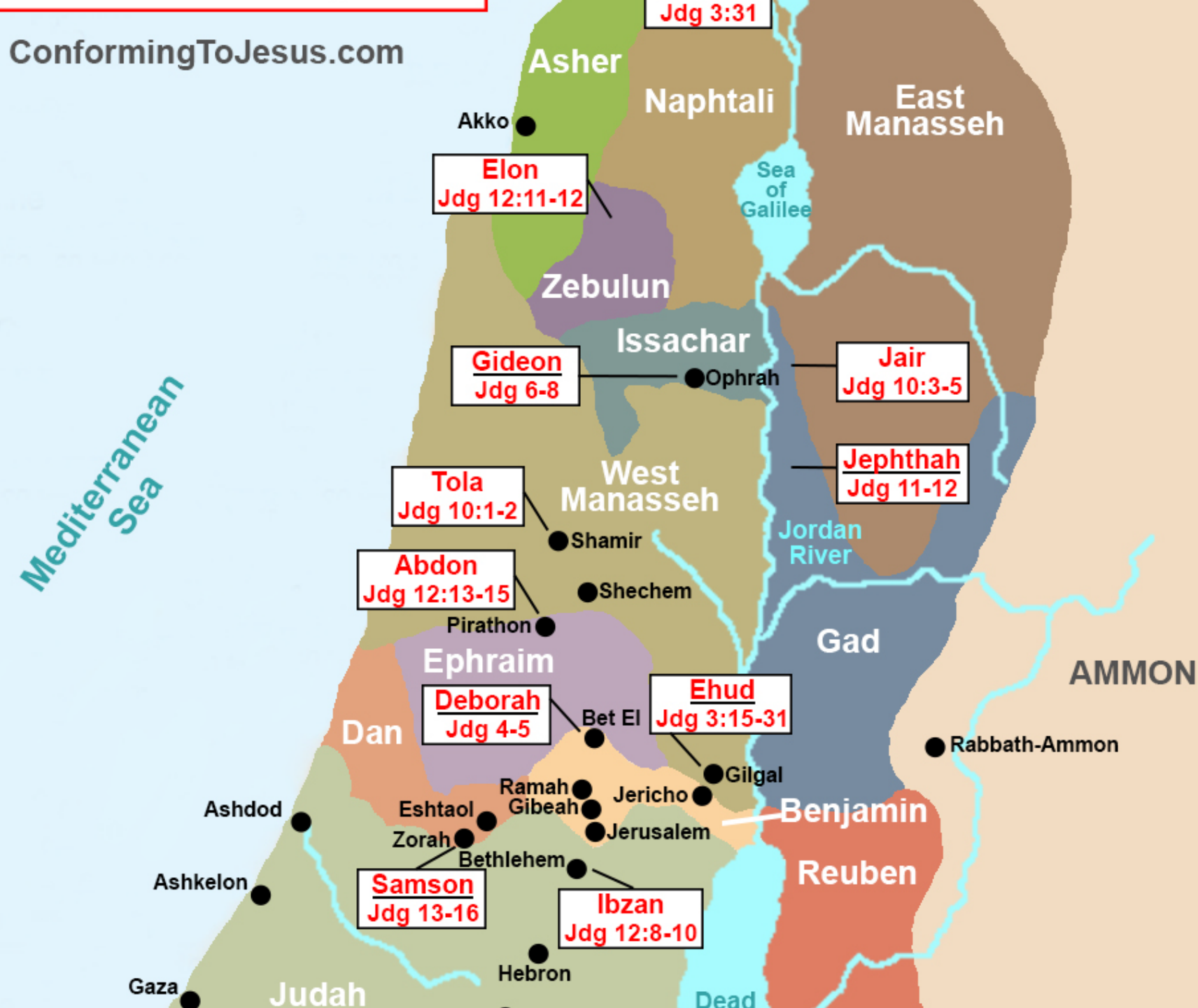
An Example of Faithfulness

Main Idea of the Text

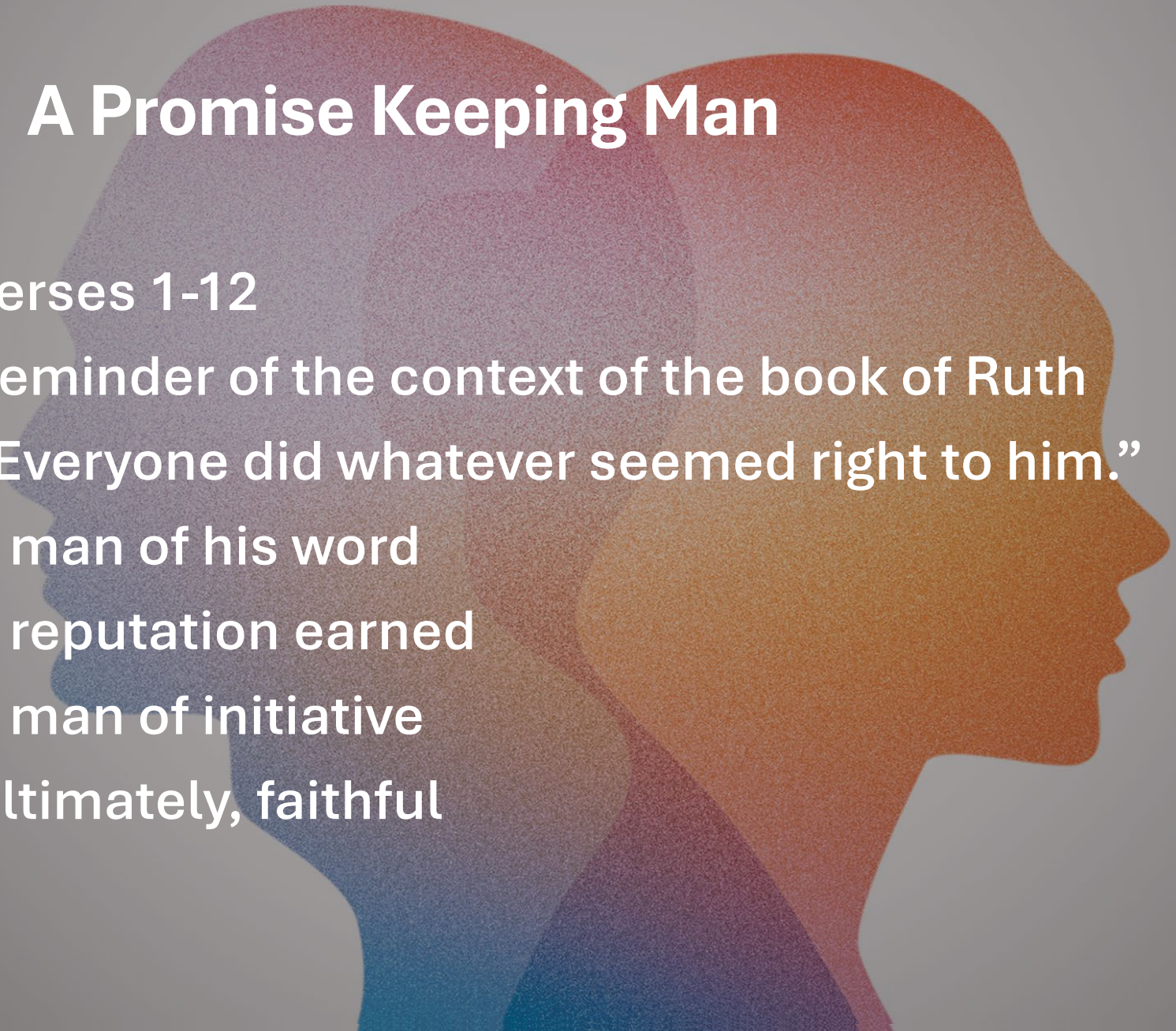
Boaz served faithfully in fulfilling his promise to Ruth. Even more so, our God is faithful from the beginning of time to the end, even when we cannot see Him or understand Him.





1. A Promise Keeping Man

- Verses 1-12
- Reminder of the context of the book of Ruth
- “Everyone did whatever seemed right to him.”
- A man of his word
- A reputation earned
- A man of initiative
- Ultimately, faithful

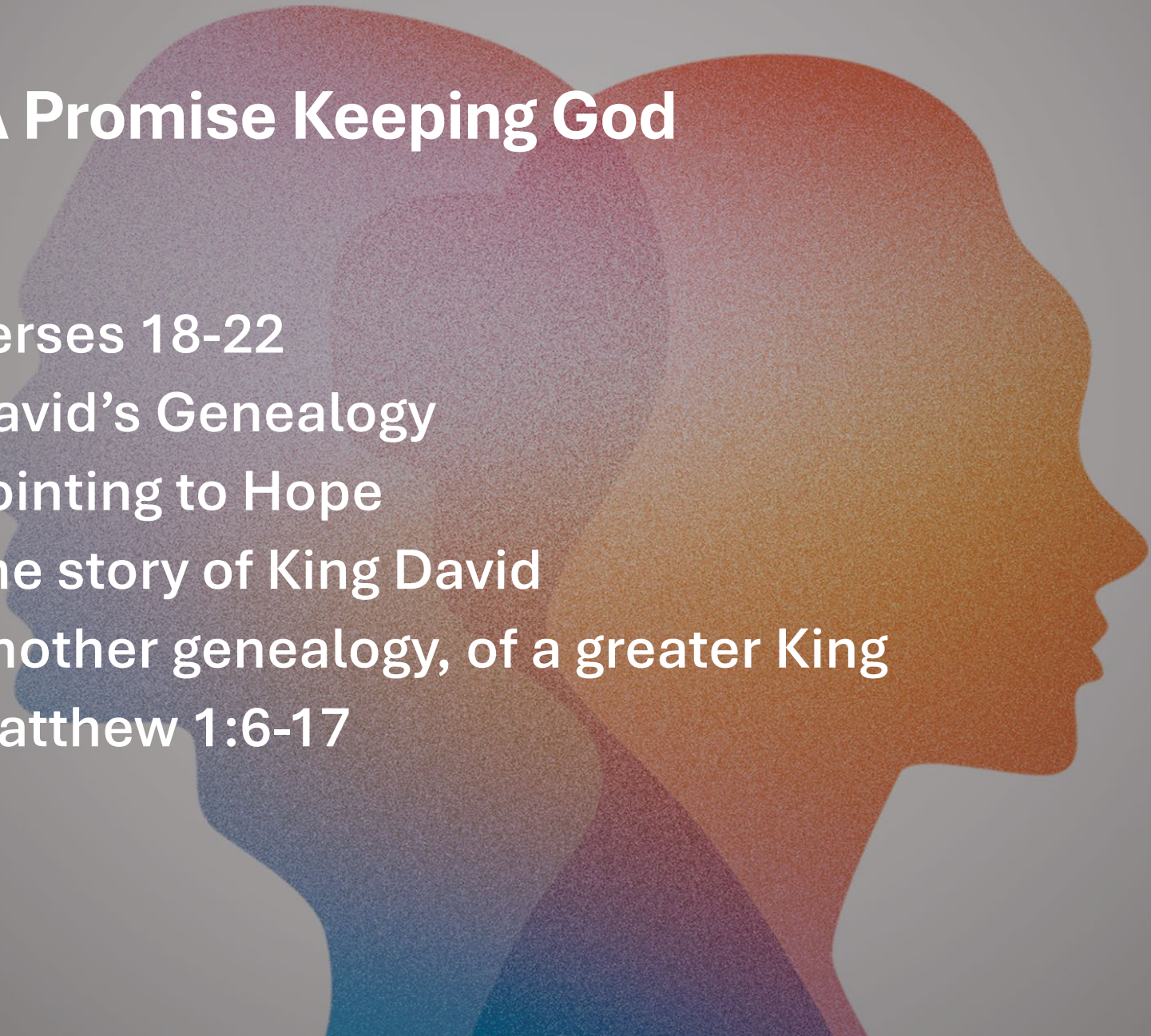


2. A Blessing from the Lord

- The birth of a son
- “The Lord granted conception to her.”
- Psalm 127:3
- God’s provision, even when we don’t understand it or expect it

3. A Promise Keeping God

- Verses 18-22
- David's Genealogy
- Pointing to Hope
- The story of King David
- Another genealogy, of a greater King
- Matthew 1:6-17
